FINANCIAL UPDATE

- *July*: Offering was about 66% of the same period in the past two years and 60% of the budgeted amount. About 60% of the offering amount was through digital giving, and 40% was mailed to church.
- *Year-to-date*: \$40,193 deficit through end of July mainly driven by offering amount reduced more than expense reduction.

By the grace of God, our church was granted a Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loan. We are working towards applying for loan forgiveness, which would help with our deficit.

We are grateful to God's provision and the contributions of brothers & sisters. This is the time for us to be spending time in prayers, to be spending time to care for others, and to be generous in giving financially if you are able.
